

Classroom Emergency Lockdown Button FAQ's

1. When Should I press the button?
 - The button should only be used for immediate threats in your vicinity.
 - The button should not be pressed every time an emergency alert (MoBull, etc,) is sent out, use your best judgment on when it is appropriate.
 - It is extremely important that you **call 911** once the button has been pressed.
 - **The button should NOT be used for Medical Emergencies.** For medical emergencies, call 911.

 2. Can I leave the secured area once the button has been pressed?
 - Yes, you can exit the secured area, but you will be unable to re-enter (the doors will be locked) until the lock is reset.

 3. How does the lock reset?
 - Once the button has been pressed, it does **not** unlock by pressing the button for a second time.
 - The button can only be reset by authorized personnel.

 4. What happens when the button is pressed?
 - Once the button is pressed, all the perimeter doors that are on the building access control system are locked to prevent access into the secured area.
 - It is extremely important that you **call 911** once the button has been pressed.
