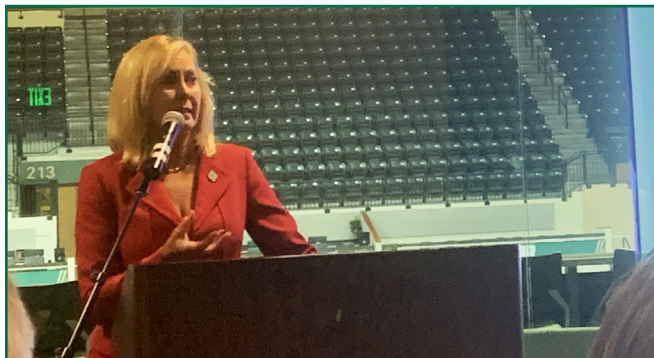


SCUP CONFERENCE
