BULL RUNNER

Information and Safety Guidelines

The Bull Runner transit system provides transportation for USF students, faculty, and staff throughout campus and designated locations off campus.

Please visit the USF's Parking & Transportation Services website (usf.edu/parking) for route details, operating schedules, and maps. Service times may vary due to special circumstances, so checking the website for up-to-date information and holiday schedules is recommended.

Visitors and individuals conducting business on campus are welcome to use the Bull Runner system by obtaining a bus pass, available at the Parking and Transportation Services office or from pay station receipts.

Please note that riders may be denied access to the Bull Runner if the guidelines are not followed.

Guidelines

- 1. Riders are required to show their USF ID upon boarding. Visitors must be accompanied by a USF student, faculty, or staff member or have a USF Bull Runner bus pass. Visitors riding as guests of USF ID holders must enter and exit the bus together.
- 2. Shirts and shoes are required.
- 3. Eating, drinking, smoking, vaping, and carrying open containers for food or drinks are prohibited on the buses.
- 4. No pets allowed. Only service dogs, secured with a harness or leash.
- 5. Parents or guardians are responsible for the safety of children under 18 years old while entering, exiting, and riding the bus. Strollers must be folded and secured to keep the aisles clear.
- 6. Anyone who distracts the driver from safely operating the bus may be asked to leave.
- 7. Passengers standing on the bus must use handrails for safety. The driver will not move the bus if passengers are standing beyond the white or yellow Standee Line.
- 8. All Bull Runner route buses are wheelchair accessible. Passengers needing assistance may use the lift or ramp, and drivers are responsible for securing all wheelchairs. Passengers seated in "Priority Seating" areas may be asked to move to accommodate individuals with disabilities or senior citizens.
- 9. Audio announcements are made at major stops, transfer points, or significant locations along the route. Passengers are responsible for announcing their stop in time for the driver to safely pull over and can be notified by the driver upon arriving at the stop. Buses only stop at designated USF Bull Runner bus stops.
- 10. When crossing the street after exiting the bus, wait until the bus has left the stop or cross behind the bus. Cars will not stop for the bus.
- The Bull Runner keeps a lost and found of non-perishable items for 7 days.
 Valuable items found on the bus are turned in to the University Police (813-974-2628) daily. Questions/concerns can be made to the Bull Runner (813-974-6902).
- 12. No e-scooters allowed inside the Bull Runner. Scooters that fit properly may be secured to the bike rack at the front of the bus.
