### USF 2022 SPRING COMMENCEMENT PARKING & TRAFFIC ALERT, MAY 6, 7, & 8, 2022

05/03/2022

USF 2022 Spring Commencement exercises for USF will be held in the Yuengling Center this Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

High traffic volumes are expected at the Leroy Collins Boulevard and Bull Run entrances off Fowler Ave leading to the Yuengling Center. Parking demand is also expected to increase in Yuengling Center lots as well as other parking lots located along Alumni, Genshaft, and Holly Drives, and Leroy Collins Blvd. Please be mindful of increased pedestrian traffic along Alumni, Genshaft, Sago and Elm Drives as guests arrive and proceed to the Yuengling Center.

Roads and traffic flow around the Yuengling Center will be closed and redirected to provide a safe pedestrian and traffic environment. Bull Run Drive will be closed from the intersection of Alumni Drive north to Elm Drive. Alumni Drive will be closed from the intersection of Leroy Collins Blvd, eastbound to Bull Run Drive.

On Friday, May 6 through Sunday, May 8 – Road closures for Commencement will begin at 8:00am and reopen at 10:00pm.

**Bull Runner Impact:** Detours on Routes A, C, D, E, and G, beginning Friday May 6 thru Sunday May 8. Normal service resumes Monday, May 9. Additionally, after 5:30 pm and on weekends, cars with valid USF parking permits

with the exception of Park-N-Ride permits may park out of their designated areas, excluding Resident and Reserved parking spaces.
