Tampa, FL: Two hundred and twenty-three law enforcement officers graduated on March 16, 2018, from the FBI National Academy Program at Quantico, Virginia, to include our own USFPD member, Lieutenant Dominick Marckese. The 271st Session of the National Academy consisted of men and women from 48 states. Included in the class were members of law enforcement agencies from the District of Columbia, 18 international countries, five military organizations, and five federal civilian organizations.

Internationally known for its academic excellence, the National Academy Program, held at the FBI Academy, offers 10 weeks of advanced communication, leadership, and fitness training for selected officers having proven records as professionals within their agencies.

Training for the program is provided by the FBI Academy instructional staff, Special Agents, and other staff members holding advanced degrees, many of whom are recognized internationally in their fields of expertise. Since 1972, National Academy students have been able to earn undergraduate and graduate credits from the University of Virginia due to the accreditation by the university of the many courses offered.

Lieutenant Marckese joins the 50,808 graduates who now represent the alumni of the FBI National Academy since it began in 1935.
