

EXPLANATION OF WAIVER FORMS

Section 438 (a) (1) (c) of the General Education Provisions Act (Buckley Amendment) provides that students shall have access to any files assembled about them. While this provision gives you access to your records, evaluations and other file materials, you should be aware that it may hinder some evaluators from candidly discussing your personal qualities and may cause professional schools to place less confidence in your evaluations. Consequently, most students choose to waive right to access. You are required to indicate in writing your desire to waive or retain your access to your evaluation file.

A statement of your decision to waive or retain the rights of the Buckley Amendment will be included with any evaluation sent from this office.
