We will also analyze recent films and tv shows that have adapted and re-interpreted these traditions & accounts for

a contemporary audience, including- <u>Beowulf,</u>
<u>Lord of the Lord of the Rings, The Dragon King,</u>
<u>Game of Thrones,</u>
<u>The Vikings & Barbarians.</u>

Additionally, we'll discuss computer games and graphic novels that adapt Germanic themes!
