


William Burke-White is Professor of Law and Inaugural Director of Perry World House at the University of Pennsylvania.



"The Future of Supreme Court Reform" with Ganesh Sitaraman

In recent years, calls for reforming the Supreme Court have gained considerable attention. Presidential candidates have called for reform; members of Congress and activists have called for expanding the size of the Court; scholars have argued for democratizing the Court by limiting its power.

Ganesh Sitaraman has written some of the leading articles analyzing Supreme Court reform (along with his coauthor Dan Epps). He will speak about why proponents think reform is necessary and discuss the pros, cons, and viability of proposed reforms.

Ganesh Sitaraman

Professor Sitaraman teaches and writes about constitutional law, regulation, economic policy, and democracy.

He is a public member of the Administrative Conference of the United States, and was a longtime advisor to Elizabeth Warren, including serving as a senior advisor on her 2020 presidential campaign, her senior counsel in the Senate, and her policy director during her 2012



