The CAS Tenure and Promotion Committee's nine members (three from each school) have been reviewing files throughout November and expect to complete the committee's work by December 1.

The committee was presented with 28 cases total. The consent agenda submitted from the school committees included 18 cases. The committee is currently performing individual reviews of the 18 cases on the consent agenda prior to voting to accept the consent agenda. As of this meeting, the committee is also still proceeding with detailed review and discussion of the 10 cases that were not on the consent agenda.
