- Summer 2016:
  - 1 student was assigned an FF grade (failure for academic dishonesty) in College of Arts and Sciences courses.
  - o 1 academic integrity appeal was elevated to the college level.
  - o 2 grievances were elevated to the college level.
- Fall 2016
  - 15 students were assigned FF grades (failure for academic dishonesty) in College of Arts and Sciences courses.
  - o 8 academic integrity appeals were elevated to the college level.
  - o 1 potential grievance was elevated to the college level.
- Spring 2017
  - Grading still in progress
  - o 2 academic integrity appeals have been elevated to the college level.
  - o 1 grievance reported/elevated to the college level.
