

## **ACADEMIC INTEGRITY AND GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE 2019-2020 REPORT**

The CASAIGC has had a busy 2019-2020 academic year. The College has been busy addressing the following:

### Policy and Process

- In preparation for consolidation, revisions were made to USF Regulation 3.027 – Academic Integrity of Students to clarify the reporting process, define the individual (or their designee) vested with the authority to impose the instructor’s recommended academic sanctions, and align the Academic Integrity and Academic Grievance processes.
- Faculty are now able to submit academic integrity violations in Canvas through the “Refer Student” button. This ensures more streamlined tracking at the university level, as well as provides more consistent messaging to students regarding next steps.
- CAS has also updated the way student appeals are addressed, including the use of standardized forms for the student, faculty, and Academic Integrity Review Board. These forms have helped streamline documentation and tracking of academic integrity appeals within the college.

### Academic Integrity

- 69 total Academic Integrity violations reported by faculty.
  - 19 Academic integrity appeal requests initiated by students.
  - 50 Notifications of academic integrity violations from faculty that have not resulted in a subsequent appeal request.
- Two (2) academic integrity violations were elevated to UGS for review of recommended sanction.

### Academic Grievance

- Four (4) academic grievances were elevated to the College level.
  - Three (3) were determined to be course complaints and not subject to the Academic Grievance Policy.
  - One (1) was addressed at the Department level.
