

Graduate Tuition Rates (Fall 2024- Summer 2025)

Tuition is assessed by course level, not student classification (i.e., if an Undergraduate student takes a Graduate level course, they are charged the Graduate tuition rate). Other factors that determine the per credit rate are residency, admission term, course campus and for some graduate students their college or program of study. Non-Florida resident students are assessed the same fees as Florida residents plus additional out-of-state fees.

All tuition and associated fees are required or authorized by the legislative bodies that govern USF which include the Florida Legislature, Florida Board of Governors and USF Board of Trustees. The per credit hour tuition rates are made up of many different fees. Below are explanations of the various fees.

STATE FEE DESCRIPTIONS

Tuition – **Graduate:** The basic tuition charged to a student for instruction provided by a public post-secondary educational institution in this state.

Tuition - Grad State Fees: Fees for both Capital Improvements and Financial Aid as described below.

- Capital Improvement Trust Fund Fee Exists to provide educational and support facilities for students, faculty, and staff in a manner that maximizes the effectiveness of the capital investment, maximizes the use of existing facilities, and promotes orderly, planned campus development.
- **Financial Aid Fee** A university board of trustees is authorized to collect, for financial aid purposes, an amount not to exceed 5% of the tuition and out-of-state fee.

LOCAL FEE DESCRIPTIONS

Tuition - Grad Local Fees: Fees for Athletics, Activities and Services and Student Health as described below.

- Athletics Fee Supplements the university's diverse athletic programs and provides students a means to enjoy university athletic events without direct cost to the student. Supports programming at athletic spaces. Assessed per credit hour and as a flat fee.
- Activities and Services Fee Supports student governing boards and programs and student organizations to improve services directly related to student activities. Assessed per credit hour and as a flat fee.
- **Student Health Fee** Funds programming that promotes healthy lifestyle choices and provides students access to the campus-based Student Health Services with many services offered at little to no direct cost to the student.

OTHER FEE DESCRIPTIONS

Tuition - Grad Transportation: Supports the USF System's transportation infrastructure.

Tuition – Grad Facilities Fee/Flat Fee Student Union: Facilitates the use of USF's student union, The Marshall Center. Assessed per credit hour and as a flat fee.

Tuition - Graduate Tech Fee: Funds the maintenance and expansion of university technology services and the expansion of wireless capabilities and services.

Tuition- GR Green Energy Fee: Is used to establish or improve the use of renewable energy technologies or energy efficiencies that directly lower greenhouse gas emissions, waste, or energy costs.

NON-FLORIDA RESIDENT FEE DESCRIPTIONS

Tuition - GR Out-of-State Fee: An additional fee added to out-of-state/non-Florida resident students who are not covered by taxpayer's funds.

Tuition - GR Out-of-State FinAid: Covers additional costs for financial aid operations and administrative costs for out of state/non-Florida resident students.

PROGRAMMATIC FEE DESCRIPTIONS

Programmatic Tuition is added tuition and fee charges assigned to specific degree programs based on high demand, high cost of delivery, and high employment potential. Programmatic tuition currently applies to all graduate students in Business and Engineering programs and the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) Nurse Anesthesiology Program.

Programmatic Tuition: Tuition charged to a student for instruction provided by a public post-secondary educational institution in this state.

Programmatic Tuition - Fin Aid: Covers Financial Aid operations and administrative costs

Programmatic Tuition- Tech Fee: This fee is used to enhance instructional technology resources for students and faculty.

DNP Program Fee: Assessed to the DNP in Nurse Anesthesiology Program students in the market-rate program.
