## How will gift card purchases work through Amazon Punch Out?

Gift cards from will also need to be purchased to be through the BMP Punch Out.

To purchase Gift Cards from through the Punch Out - you'll still be required to have an approved Gift Card purchase agreement on file with P-card, but rather than the P-card team auditing your statement after the fact, P-card team members will be in the BMP workflow to proactively review and approve before your make your purchase. They will maintain the list of approved Gift Card purchasers and compare the buyer to names on that list. Only individuals with an approved and active Gift Card Purchase Agreement will be allowed to purchase these items.

Other than that, the process of ordering should be the same. You can still send digital cards to multiple recipients through Amazon.
