# University of South Florida Direct Support Organizations and Health Services Support Organizations April 2025

A **Direct Support Organization (DSO)** is a separate, not-for-profit Florida corporation organized under Section 1004.28, Florida Statutes, and is operated exclusively to assist the University achieve excellence by providing supplemental resources from private gifts and bequests and valuable educational support services. The Statute authorizes these organizations to receive, hold, invest, and administer property and to make expenditures to or for the benefit of the University.

A Health Services Support Organization (HSSO) is a separate, not-for-profit corporation organized under Section 1004.29, Florida Statutes to benefit the University's academic health services center by entering into arrangements with other entities as providers in other integrated health care systems or similar entities.

Each DSO and HSSO are required to provide for an annual financial audit of its financial statements conducted by an independent certified public accountant, and the annual audit report is submitted to the Board of Trustees, the Board of Governor's Office and the Auditor General.
