Mr. Aiton has served in the Senior Executive Service as the Assistant Director of Intelligence (AJ2), United States Central Command since November 2021. In this role, he enables the operationalization of intelligence against key adversaries in the USCENTCOM area of responsibility.

Between 2007 and 2021, Mr. Aiton served in various capacities within DIA's Directorate for Operations - focusing on worldwide DoD HUMINT operations. During this time, he conducted numerous deployments to Guantanamo, Afghanistan, Iraq and Southeast Asia in both combat and embassy environments and served as the Director for HUMINT and Counterintelligence (J2X) at US Africa Command.

Between 1999 and 2007 - Mr. Aiton served as an Imagery Analyst with the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency at the Pentagon's National Military Command Center and with the CIA's Counterterrorism Center.

Mr. Aiton's military experience includes enlisted service in the US Army as an Intelligence Analyst with the 101st Airborne Division and USINDOPACOM Headquarters. He then received a Direct Commission in the US Navy Reserve as an Intelligence Officer and currently serves with the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff J2. His former positions include Officer-in-Charge of JTF Guantanamo's Interrogation Detachment; Executive Officer, Special Operations Command -Europe; and Attaché tours in Sri Lanka, Nepal, Taiwan, and Thailand.

Mr. Aiton holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminology from the University of Maryland/College Park, a Master of Science in Public Administration from Central Michigan University and a Master of Arts in National Security Strategy & Policy from the US Naval War College.
