

How to Download Apps from Other Countries Android

A number of applications are area-specific i.e. they function only in specific regions. There are multiple reasons for this:

- The services provided by the app are not available in your country due to **imposed restrictions**. For example, **TikTok** is banned in India and many other countries.
- The **servers** required to run the app are only available in certain countries.
- The app may be undergoing tests and is still in the **development stage**. Hence, it may take longer to be launched in your country or region.
- The developer of the app has **restricted access** to a certain region.

If you have come across an app that does not function in your country, all hope is not lost. By following the methods listed in this guide, you will be able to download Android Apps not available in your country. 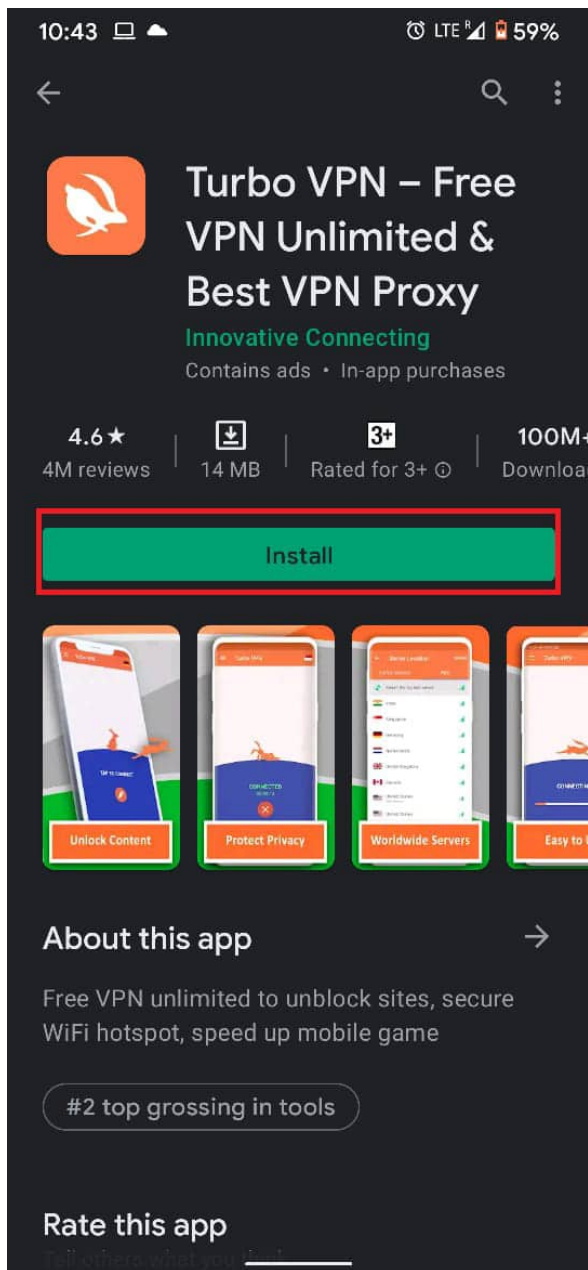
Note: Since smartphones don't have the same Settings options, and they vary from manufacturer to manufacturer hence, ensure the correct settings before changing any.

Method 1: Use a VPN Service

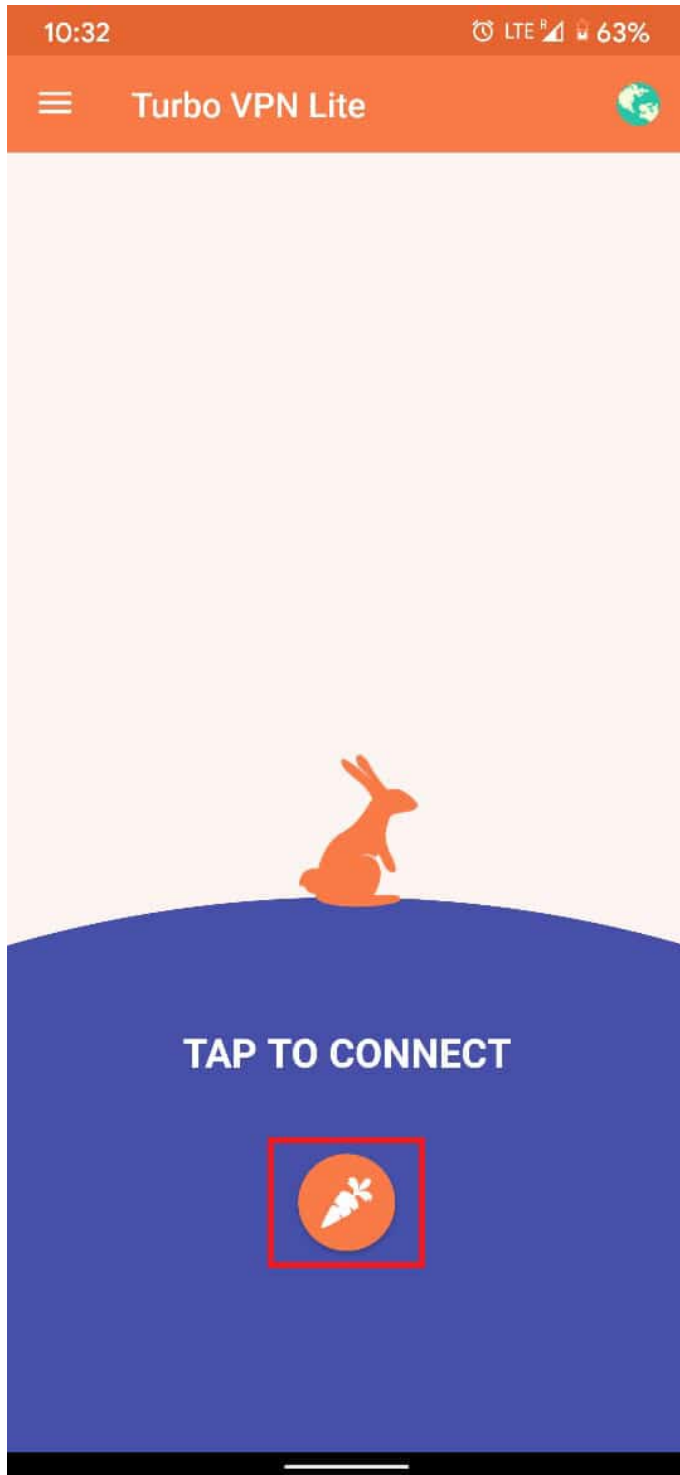
VPN or **Virtual Private Network** allows users to generate a virtual IP address for their device. This hides their phone from regional servers and forces the Android operating system to believe that it's in a different location. Most VPN services allow users to select the location of their choice. This means that you can set the VPN location to the origin country

of the app and then, download the app from the Play Store. Here's how to download Android Apps not available in your country using VPN:

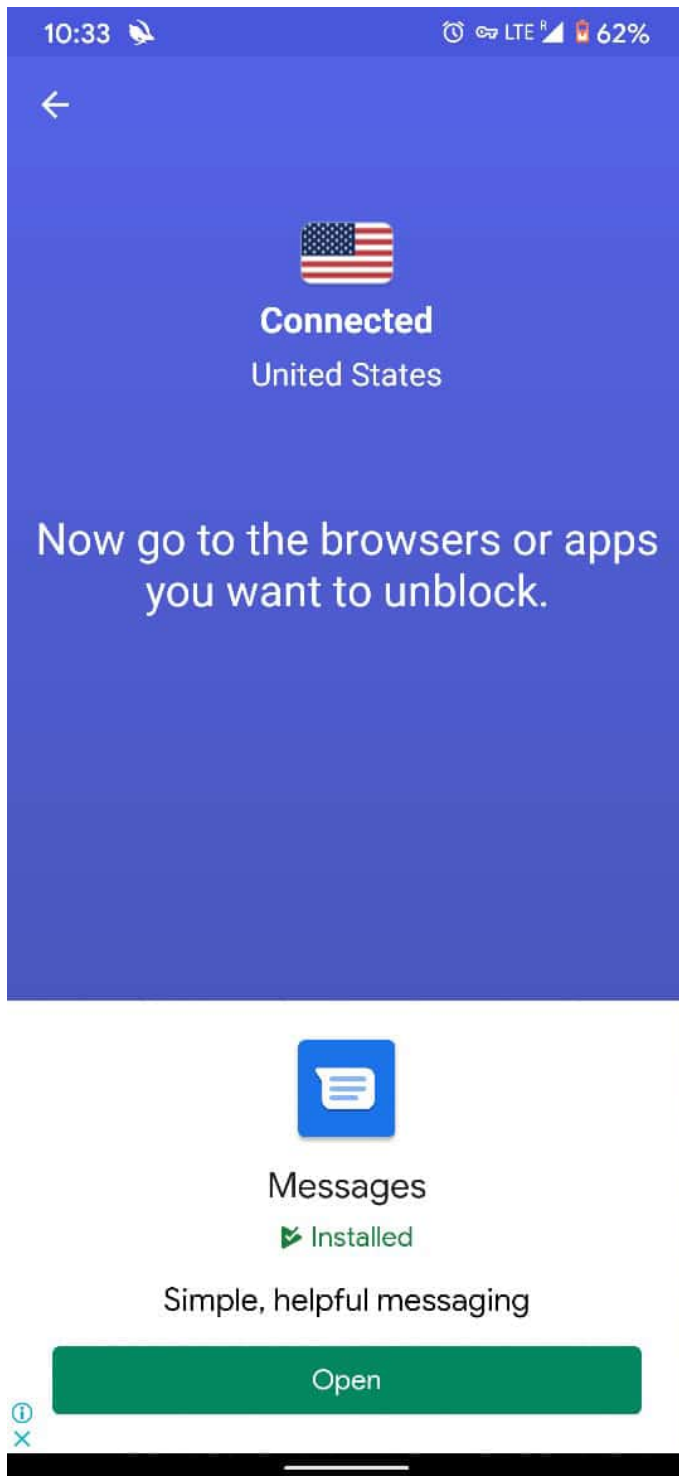
1. Launch Google **Play Store**, and **download** any VPN app of your choice. We recommend **Turbo VPN** which provides quality VPN service for free.



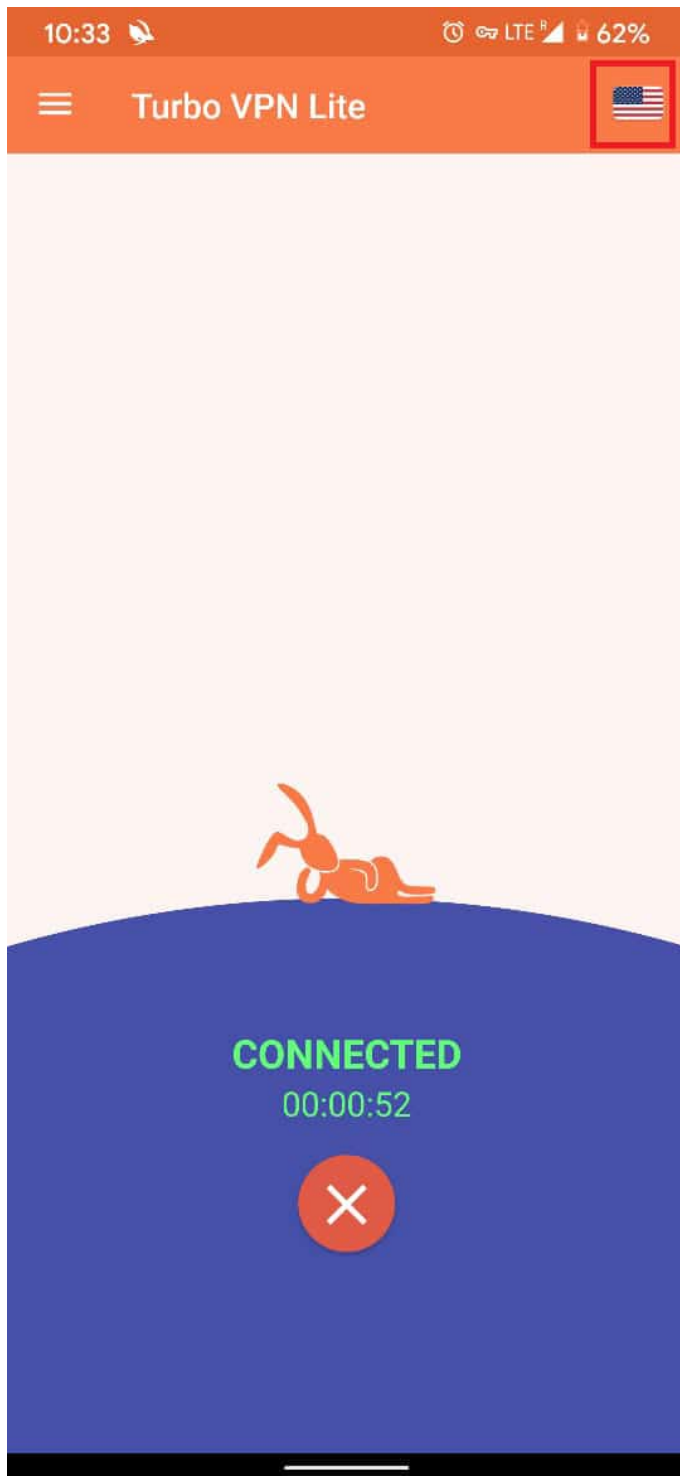
2. Open **Turbo VPN** and tap on the **Orange Carrot icon**, as shown.



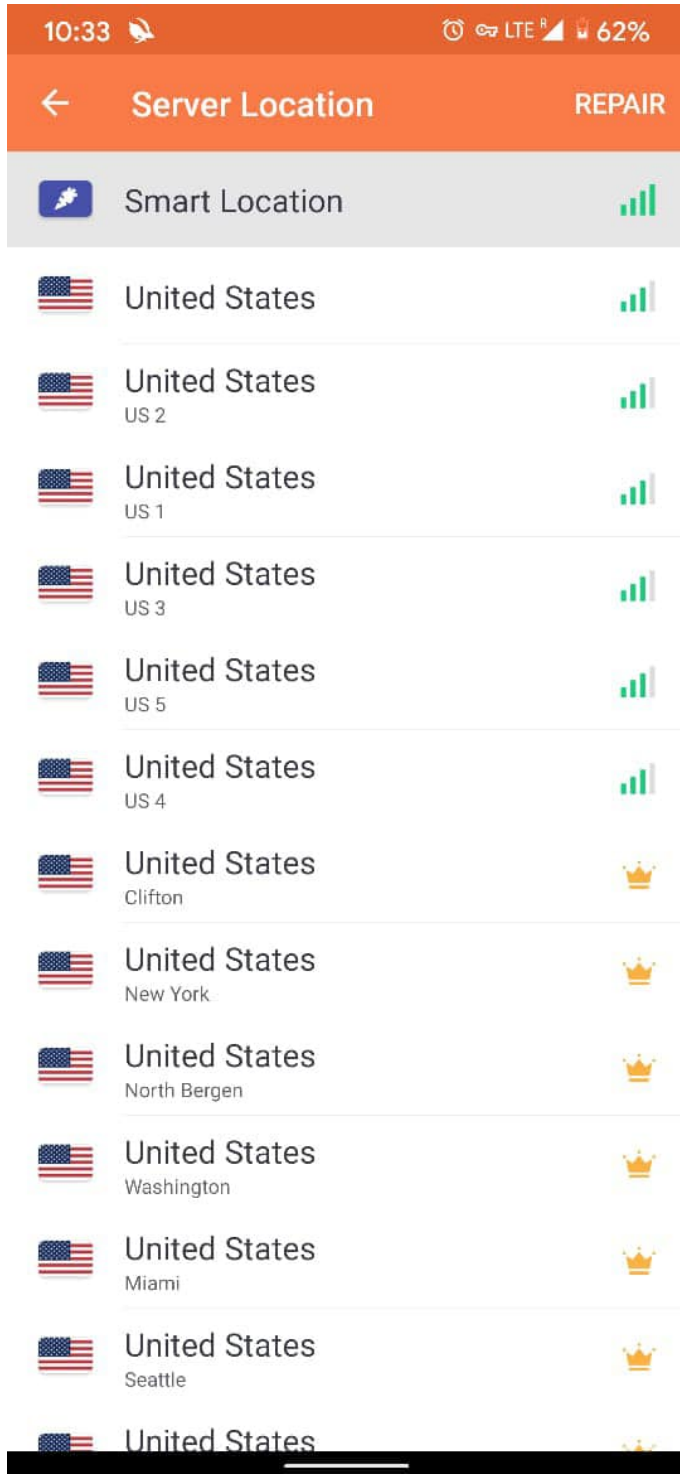
3. The app will automatically, connect you to the fastest VPN available at that time.



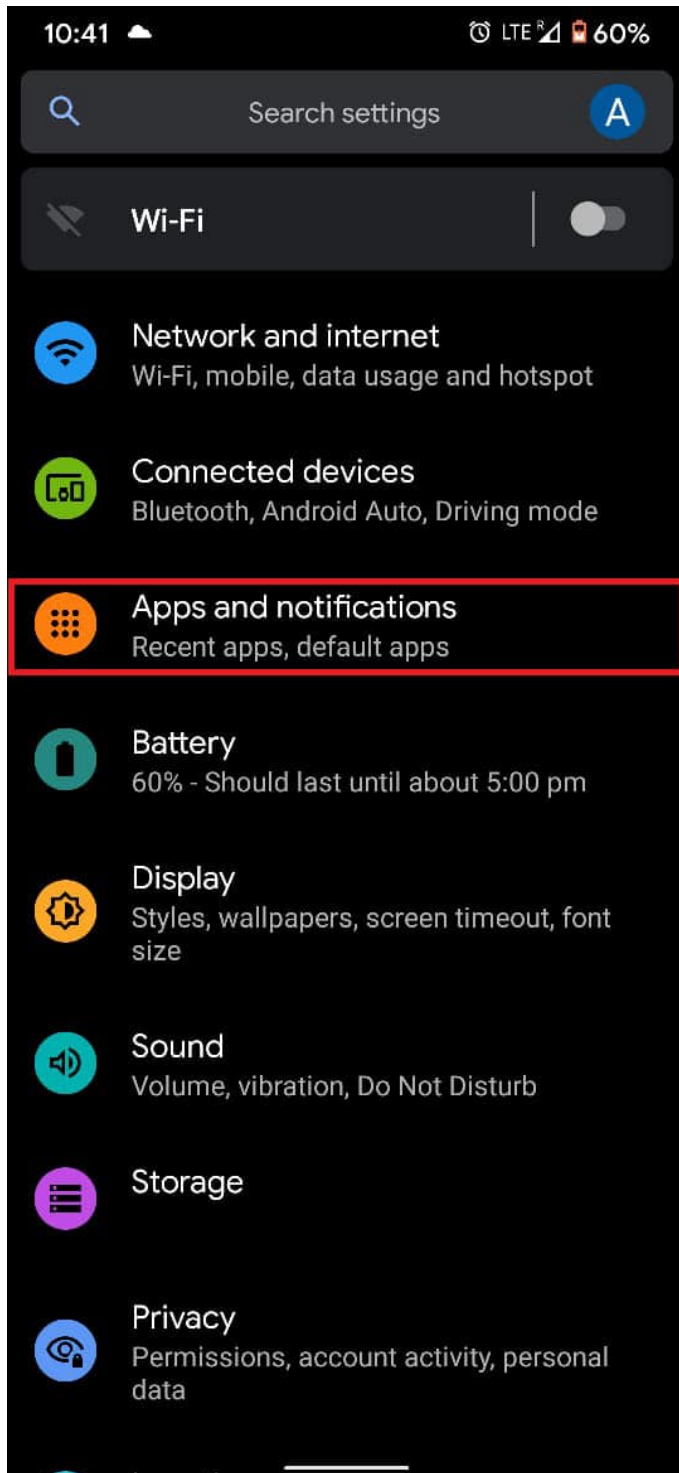
4. From the **App Home screen**, tap on the **country flag** from the top right corner of the screen.



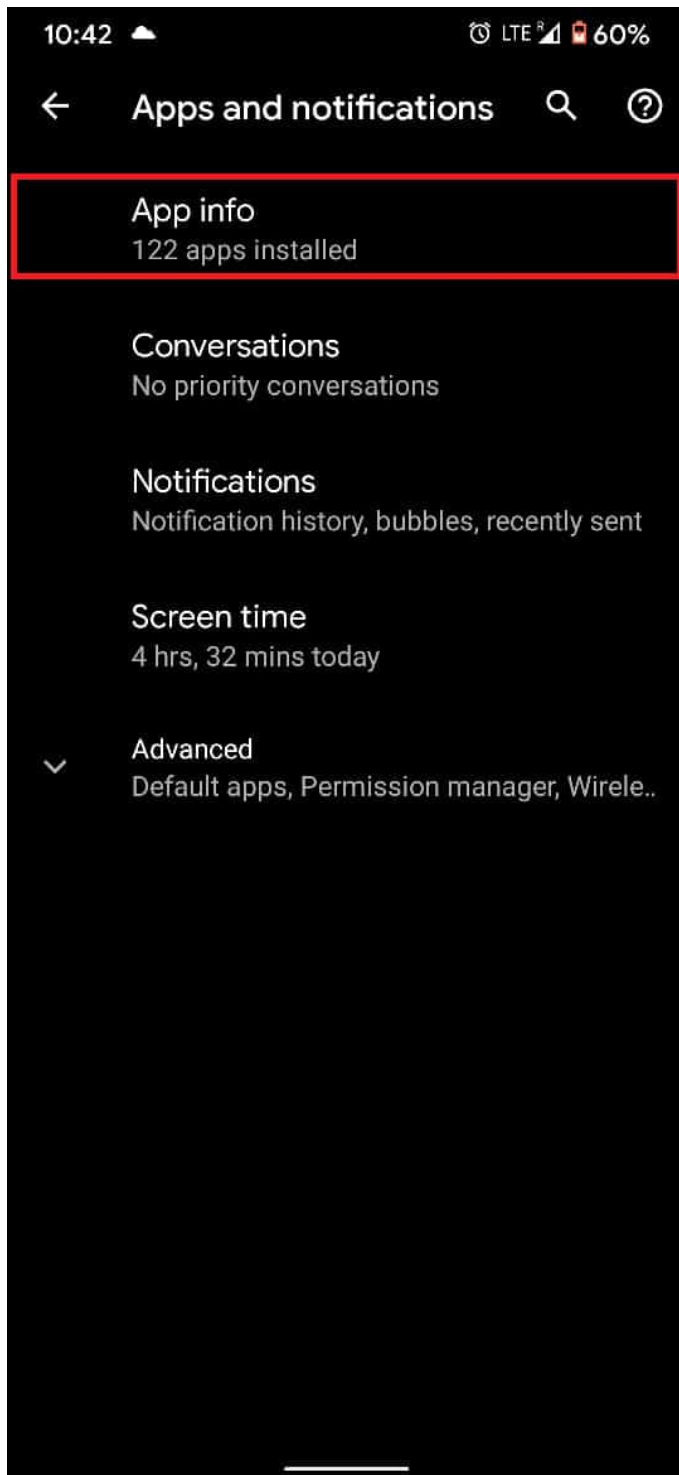
5. This will show the list of all available VPNs from that country, in this case, USA. **Select a VPN** based on your requirements. (United States Tampa)



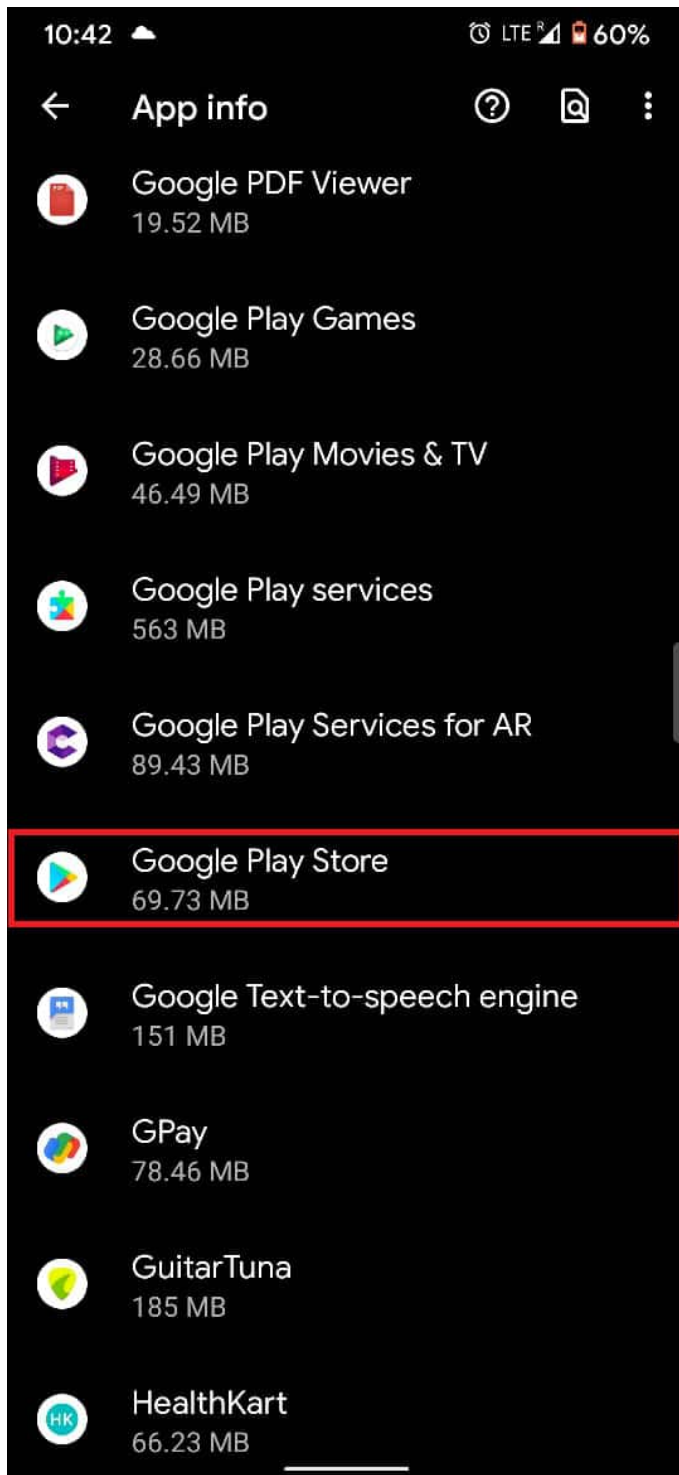
6. Next, open the **Settings** app on your Android device. Then, tap on **Apps and notifications**, as depicted.



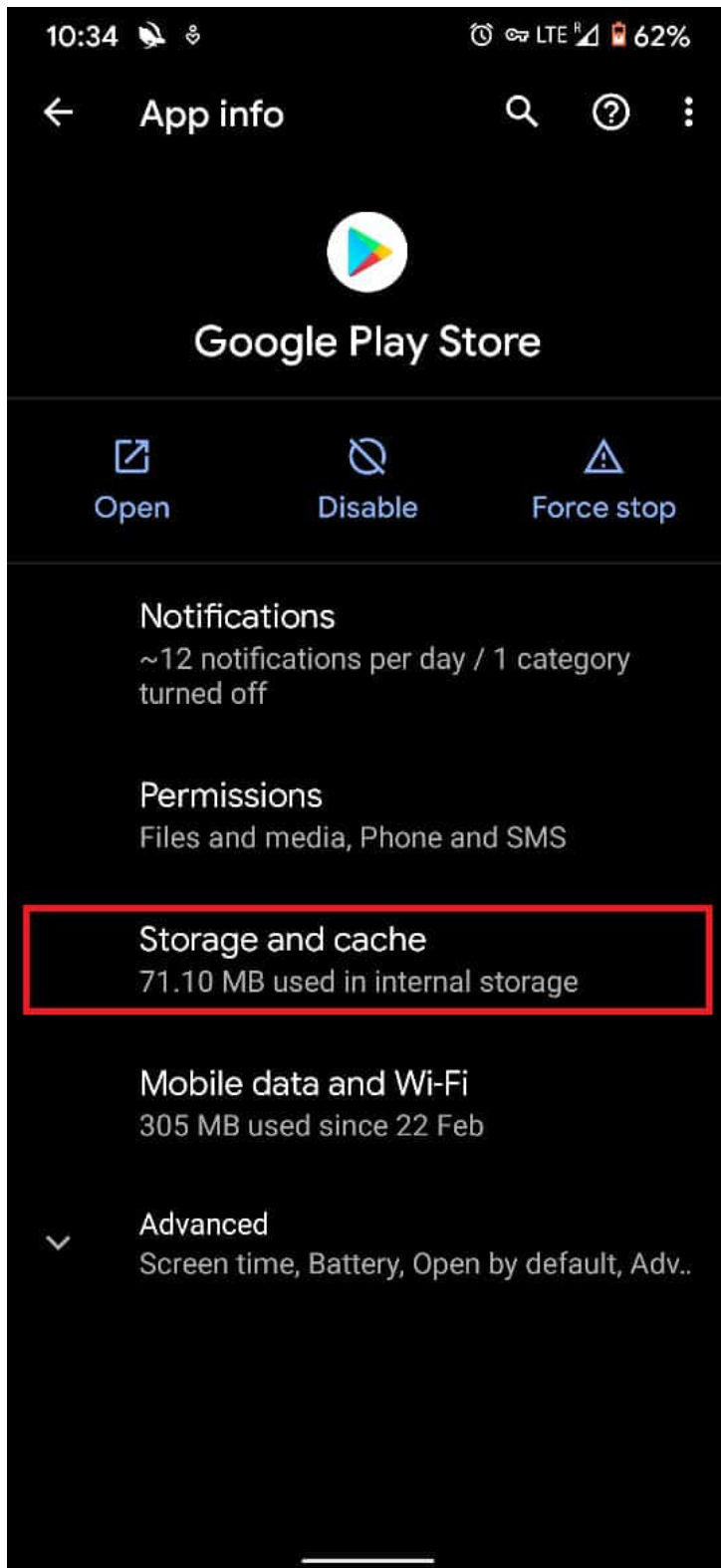
7. Tap **App info**, as shown below.



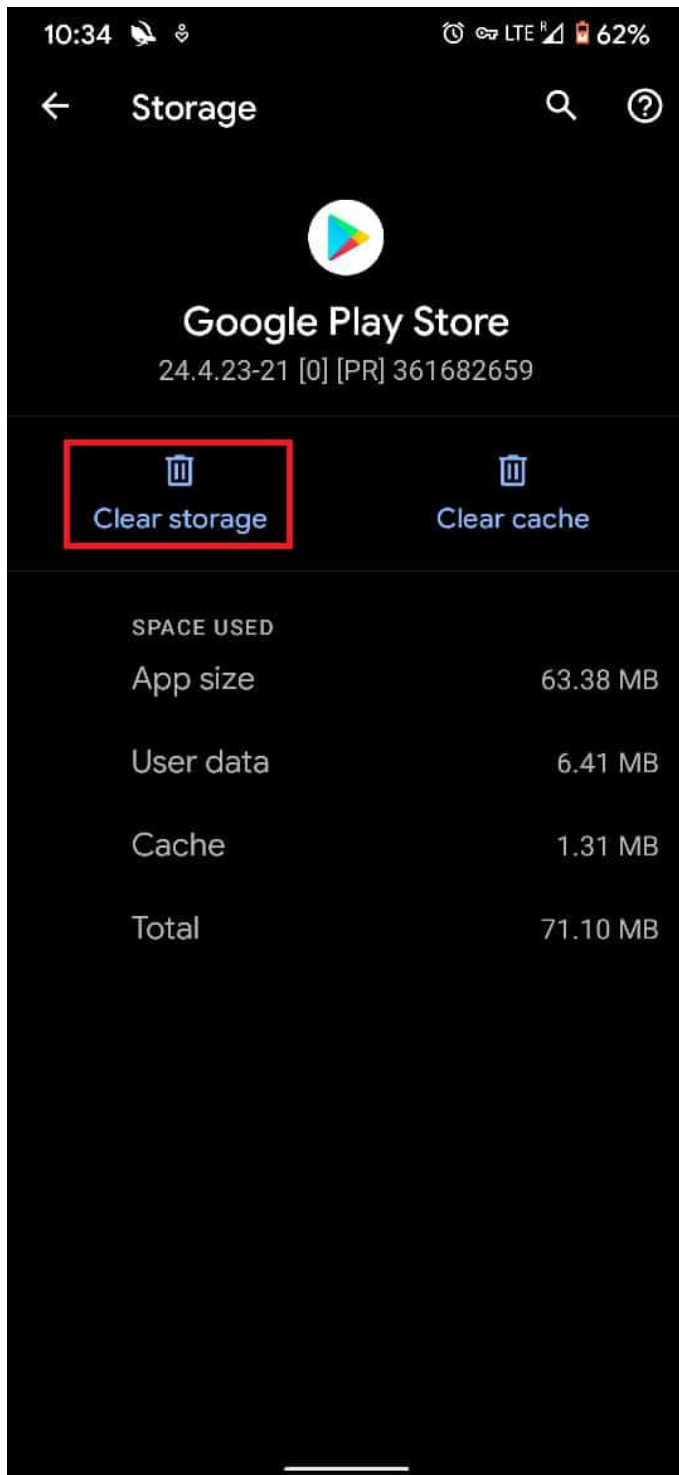
8. Find **Google Play Store** and tap on it.



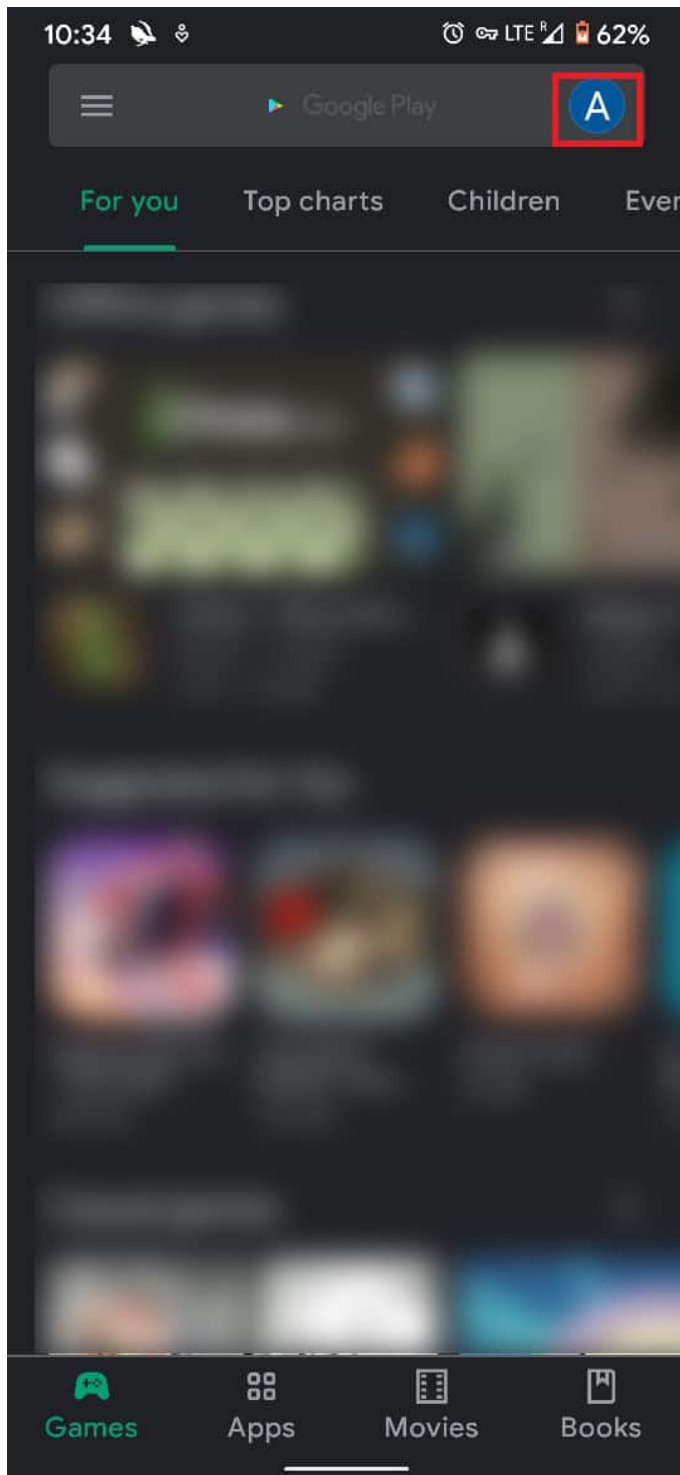
9. On the app info page, tap on **Storage and cache**.



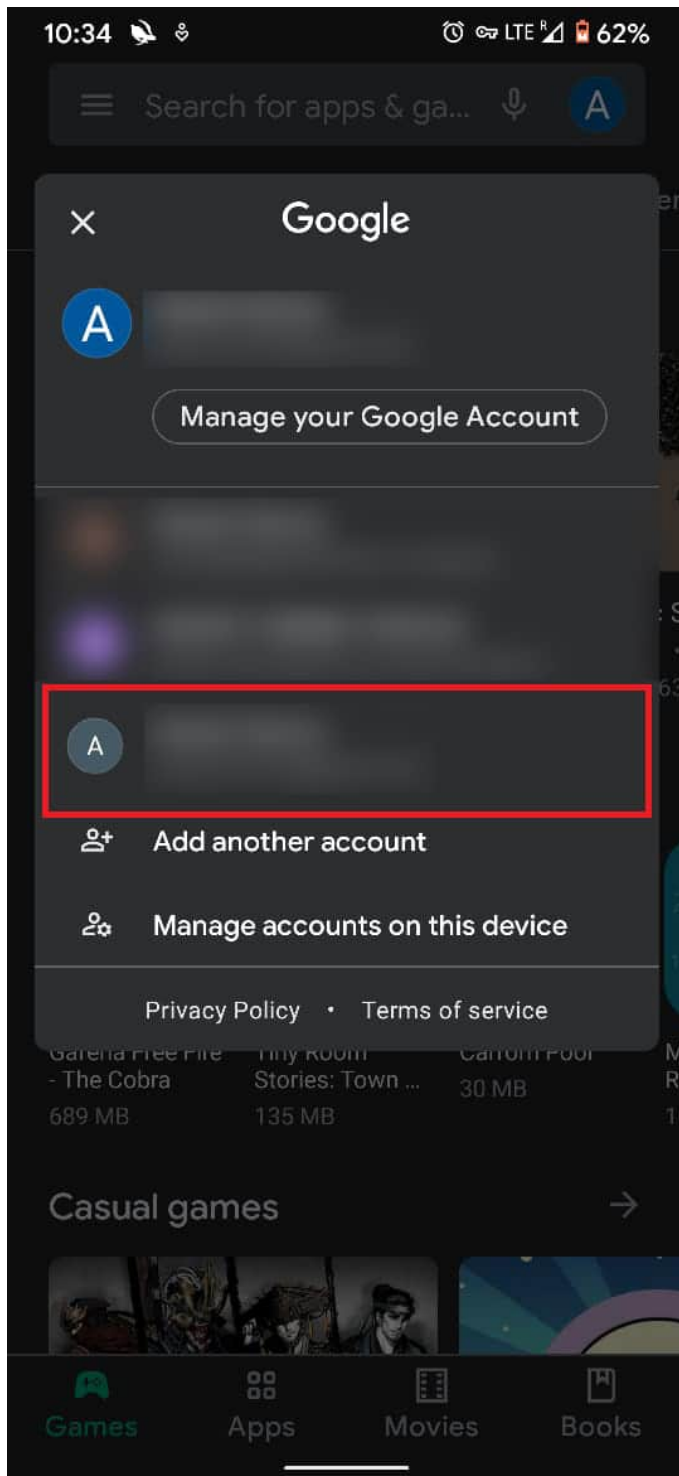
10. Tap on **Clear storage** to reset your Play Store app.



11. Relaunch **Play Store** and tap on your **Profile pic**, as depicted.



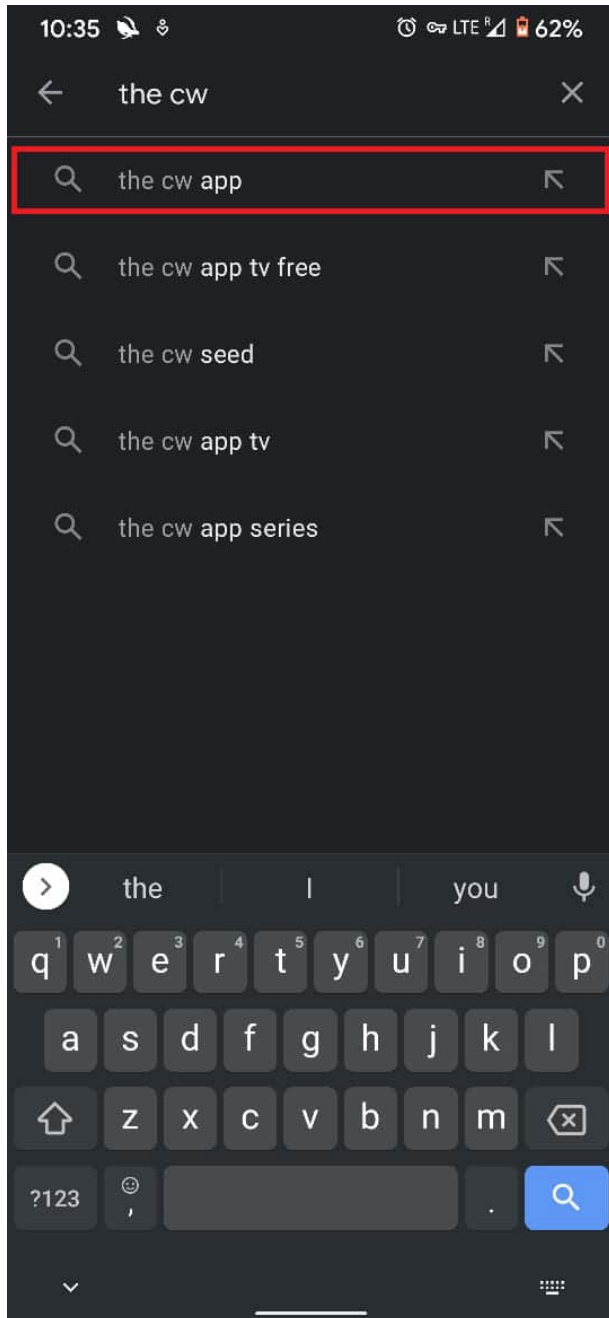
12. Switch to a **different Google account** to better mask your location. This step is **optional**.



13. Now, **search** for the region-specific app that you want to download.

14. The app should now be available for download. So, tap on **Install**, as highlighted.

Alternatives to Solve “that App Is Not Available in Your Country’s iPhone”

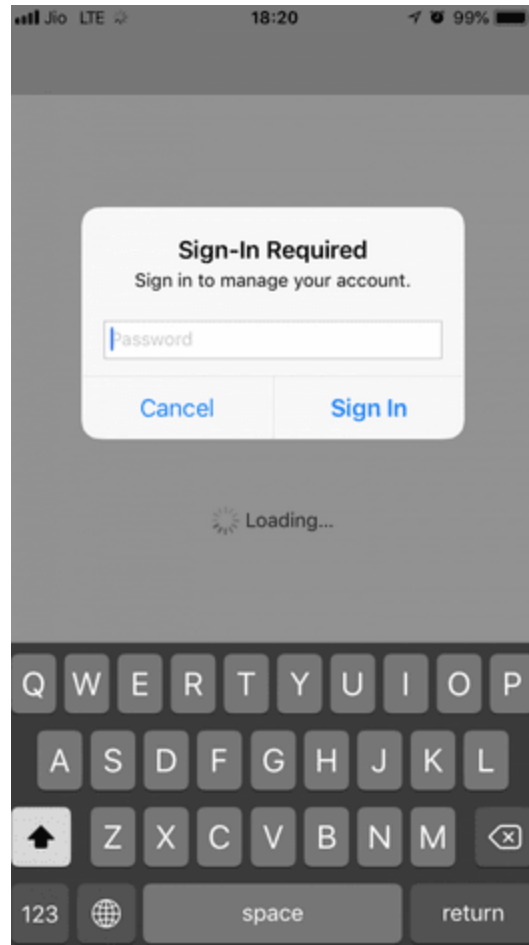
Solution: Create a New Apple ID

1. Go into your App store, tap human (or your picture) icon at the top right corner and sign out of your existing ID.

2. To create your new Apple ID, you can follow the link: <https://appleid.apple.com/#!/&page=signin>. Fill in all the required fields. And select the new country, from where your desired app belongs to (USA). Tap Continue. With this, you’ll receive a verification code via email. Enter the code on your device, and your new Apple ID will automatically be created.



3. Now launch the App Store and search for the App you want to download. Once you click on the install button, a message will appear asking you to sign in again with your new Apple ID.



4. After signing in with your new credentials you will be asked to enter specific details about the account billing information. Enter Apple ID. For mode of payment, select “None”. Fill out the U.S Billing Address, contact information and click “Next” to proceed. In your new ID, do not add your credit card information.

5. Now your device is all set to fix “this app is not available in your country or region” message and you can download any free App you want.

Note

1. Try googling Fake NYC Phone Numbers and choose one to fill the Contact Number field. Apple doesn't verify the Phone Number here, so don't worry.
2. This method only allows you to install free apps. To get paid ones, you should have a credit card in a specific country and fill the billing address of that country.
