

CANVAS QUIZ COPY

Duplicating a Quiz in the Same Course

This guide outlines the safest way to copy a Canvas Quiz within the same course or when you're copying a quiz for a second time from one course to another. To ensure that the integrity of the quiz is maintained and to reduce error in copying a quiz, please follow the steps below.




Select the Course where the quiz to be copied is found.

Select Settings at the bottom of the course navigation menu.





On the right-hand side, select **Export Course Content**.






Select **Quiz** under Export Type and deselect **All Quizzes** by unchecking the box. Then choose the quiz you want to export and press the **Create Export** button.





Once the process is complete, a **New Export** link will appear at the top of the page. Select **New Export** and save the file to the computer.






At this point, it is recommended that you change the name of the original quiz in Canvas, even if it's only temporary, before importing the copy back in (see next step) to distinguish the two quizzes from one another.


Within the course you're duplicating to (this could be the same course or a different one with another version of the same quiz), select **Settings** at the bottom of the course navigation menu.



On the settings page, select **Import Course Content** found on the right-hand menu.




From the Content Type box, scroll to the bottom and select Qti .zip file.


Under Source, select and upload the file you saved earlier. Then scroll to the bottom and select **Import.**



To confirm the import was successful, a green completion icon will appear to the right of the file.



Choose Quizzes in the course navigation menu, and the copied quiz will be visible.



If the quiz is duplicated within the same course, on the right-hand side, select the three dots. Then select **Edit**.
