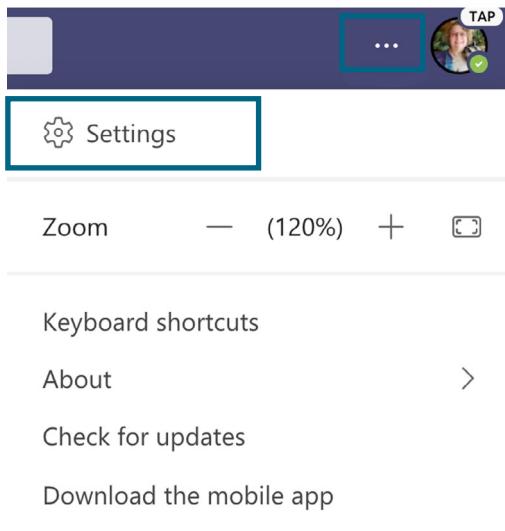
## TESTING YOUR MICROPHONE AND WEBCAM IN TEAMS

### ▶ Making a Test Call

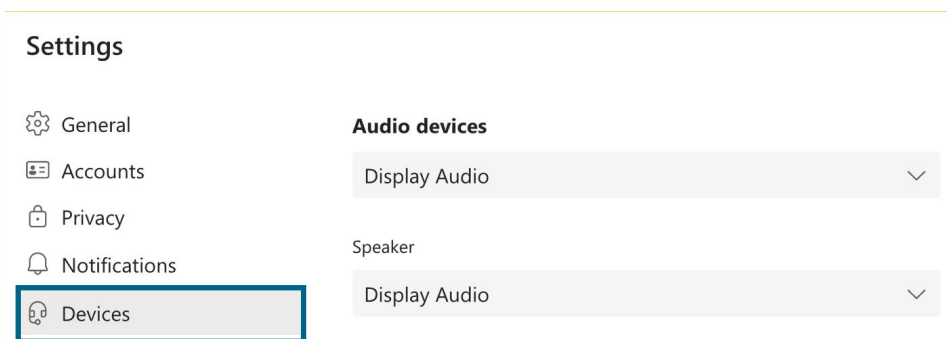

To check your microphone and webcam select the **ellipsis [...]** next to your profile picture in the top right corner of your Teams app and choose **Settings**.



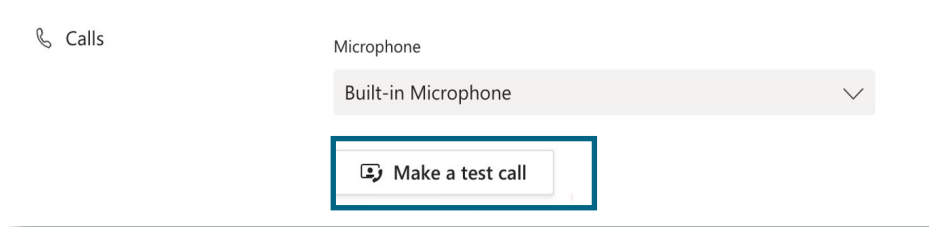

Once you are in the settings menu, click on the **Devices** menu option on the left-hand side.



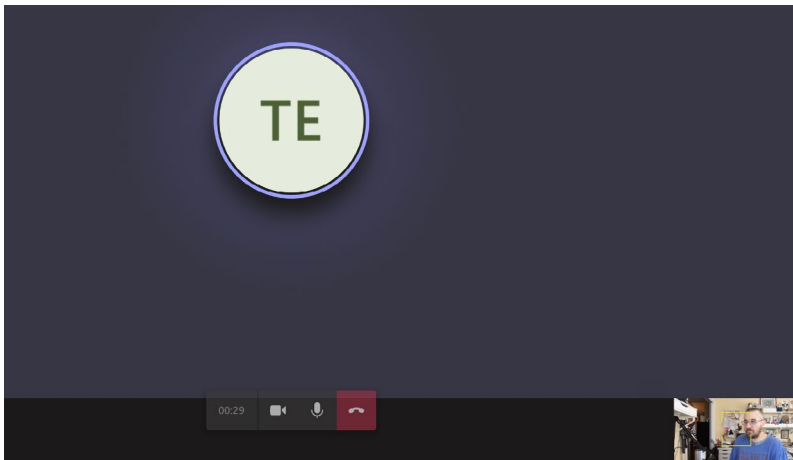

From this menu you can choose Make a test call to check and see if your microphone and webcam are working.



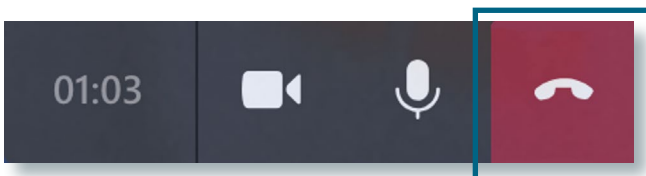

The Test Call will show you your webcam in the bottom right corner and a recording will walk you through a test of your microphone. Follow the instructions the recording gives you.

After you complete the test call, end the call by pressing the red phone icon.
