Susan is on the Board of the Solar & Energy Loan Fund which provides financing for energy efficiency and solar in underserved frontline communities. She served on the Florida Commission on Volunteer Service from 2013-2018 appointed by both former Governors Charlie Crist and Rick Scott Susan was Founding Chair of the Florida Commission on the Status of Women.
