INSTRUCTIONS FOR FINAL EXAMS

- Each fall and spring semester, the last full week of classes before final examinations is designated as Test Free Week. The intent of this policy is to establish a one week period of substantial and predictable study time for students. (See <u>Policy 10-005</u> for further details)
- Online Courses:
 - Meets Synchronously online, schedule the exam on Sunday during Block Final Exam weekend.
 - The exam can be conducted either online or in a requested room.
 - Meets Asynchronously online (with no set days & times), instructor will decide the final exam timing.
- Courses Outside Approved Meeting Time Patterns:
 - For courses that meet outside of approved meeting time patterns, coordinate with the Academic Space & Scheduling to determine exam day and time options during Standard Final Exam week.
 - The instructor is responsible for notifying students of the scheduled exam time.
- Exam Rooms and Duration:
 - Exams have a maximum time limit of two hours, but shorter durations are acceptable.
 - Block final exams MUST be scheduled during the specified Block Final Examination periods on Saturday and Sunday.
 - Block final exam rooms are assigned by the Academic Space & Scheduling based on capacity and times.
 - Standard final exams are to be held in the same classroom as the course has been in all semester long.
- Time Blocks:
 - All exams must adhere to **regular exam time blocks** to prevent conflicts for both students and rooms.
 - When time-of-class examinations conflict, the course with the higher number will take priority.
 - Instructors giving make-up exams will notify Academic Space and Scheduling with the preferred day: Tuesday-Thursday during the last time block during standard final exams.
 - Students with accommodations through the office of Student Accessibility Services (SAS) review final exam guidelines at <u>Student Accessibility Services (usf.edu)</u>.
