

Priority registration is an accommodation approved by Student Accessibility Services based on appropriate disability documentation. This accommodation allows the student to sign up for classes on the first day of registration. As with other accommodations, the student is responsible for taking advantage of this priority registration accommodation by clearing any registration 'Holds,' prior to the first day of registration.

When does priority registration begin?

You can find the first day of registration by going on-line to www.usf.edu. Then click on:

- Academics
- Courses & Calendar
- Academic Calendars
- Registrar's Event Calendar
- Look for "Benchmark Registration for degree-seekers begins..."

Where do I find the Course Schedule?

Course registration is completed through <u>MyUSF</u>. Log in to view your registration appointment time and prepare to register for classes through OASIS.

Which classes should I register for?

Plan your desired schedule and meet with your academic advisor for your college/department. Also, if necessary, schedule an appointment to meet with your SAS coordinator to discuss any disability issues related to your schedule.

Always plan a schedule that facilitates accessing your accommodations (e.g., if one of your accommodations is extended time for exams, do not register for back to back classes. Or, possible medication issues may preclude registering for morning classes.)
