CAPTAIN CHARLES BYRON WILSON

Captain C. Byron Wilson is the Branch Chief of Acquisition Policy, Air Force Installation Contracting Center (AFICC), Operating Location Air Mobility Command, Scott AFB, Illinois. He is responsible for providing contract clearance, guidance, and policy management to 10 Air Force contracting squadrons of more than 500 personnel who conduct over 10,000 contracting actions valued over \$1 billion annually. Before AFICC OL-AMC, Capt Wilson was Category Management Flight Commander, 763d Enterprise Sourcing Squadron. He provided contract execution and leadership for 18 personnel managing a \$2 billion multi-command portfolio and obligating \$200 million annually.

Capt Wilson graduated from Columbia College in 2007 and enlisted in the United States Air Force in 2010, serving as a Contract Specialist, Contract Administrator, and Contingency Contracting Officer. Capt Wilson graduated from Officer Training School and earned his commission in 2017. He has held contracting positions at the operational, enterprise, and center levels, performing as a Contracting Officer, Team Lead, Officer-in-Charge, Flight Commander, and Acquisition Policy Branch Chief. His assignments include bases in Alabama, California, Texas, and Illinois. He deployed to the USCENTCOM and USINDOPACOM Areas of Responsibilities as a Contingency Contracting Officer and Flight Chief in support of Operations INHERENT RESOLVE and FREEDOM'S SENTINEL. He holds DOD Acquisition Level III Certification in Contracting and Level I in Program Management.
