





OFFICE OF ACADEMIC ADVOCACY

90% of First Time-In-College (FTIC) from the 2021 Tampa cohort enrolled in Year 2 (5324 total cohort).

97% of the FTIC 2022 cohort from Tampa campus progressed from Fall to Spring (5921 total cohort).

63% of Florida College System Associate of Arts Transfer Students from the 2019 cohort at Tampa campus graduated in 3 years (1984 total cohort).
