

## FUSE Information

The FUSE program requires all students to meet degree requirements at the University of South Florida and the corresponding partner institution which grants the Associate of Arts degree.

### General information

- The FUSE program requires students to meet regularly and frequently with academic advisors to ensure program success.
- Some programs at USF will require an additional application to the specific college in addition to the general USF application. If requirements and deadlines are met, the student will still have the guaranteed admission to USF and the major that FUSE promises. Check individual grad paths for deadlines and any other additional requirements.

- The posted graduation pathway lists courses required for degree completion; it DOES NOT LIST ALL potential courses and does not include any remediation. Certain majors will require specific grade requirements in mandatory courses as well as cumulative GPA requirements upon transfer to USF. Check with academic advisors to ensure all AA and baccalaureate degree requirements are being met.

- It is recommended to take courses in sequence when possible, through a plan developed in consultation with advising at the Florida College System and USF. However, the recommended sequence may differ depending on student circumstances.
- The USF Application should be filled out in the spring term of year 2 of the AA degree (or last term of the year leading into intended transfer) to ensure timely review.
