The Meaning of Indigeneity to Saraguros Jazlyn Gregory, Stetson University HON 3042

THE RESEARCH ANALYZES THE MEANING OF INDIGENEITY TO THE INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES OF SARAGURO, ECUADOR. THE HYPOTHESIS PROPOSES THAT RESIDING IN SARAGURO, ECUADOR, BEING BORN INDIGENOUS, AND CONTINUING TRADITIONAL PRACTICES SUCH AS LANGUAGE AND LONG HAIR IDENTIFIES SOMEONE AS INDIGENOUS SARAGURO. THE FINDINGS SHOWED THAT THE IMPORTANT FACTOR OF INDIGENEITY IS THE COMMUNITY AND THOUGH PHYSICAL FACTORS SUCH AS LONG HAIR, CLOTHES, AND LANGUAGE ARE IMPORTANT, IT IS NOT WHAT DEFINES THEM. EMIGRATION IS A THREAT TO LOSING THIS IDENTITY, BUT THE CHILDREN OF INDIGENEITY ARE ACTIVELY PARTICIPATING IN THEIR COMMUNITIES AND CONTINUING THE INDIGENOUS IDENTITY DESPITE THE PUSHBACK FROM MODERN POLITICIANS.

Cross-Cultural Competency: Learning How to Learn About Other Cultures

MY PRESENTATION WILL EXPLORE THE IMPACT OF CROSS-CULTURAL MEDIA EXCHANGE ON OUR CONVERSATIONS WITH PEOPLE FROM ALL ACROSS THE GLOBE, WHICH CAN HELP US TO BRIDGE GAPS AND GAIN A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF ONE ANOTHER.

Globally Biased: How Ideology Shapes Worldview

HOW DOES IDEOLOGY SHAPE AMERICAN VIEWS OF FOREIGN NATIONS? THIS PRESENTATION EXAMINES HOW POLITICAL BELIEFS INFLUENCE OPINIONS OF OTHER COUNTRIES. THIS ONGOING QUANTITATIVE RESEARCH IS SPARKED BY CURIOSITY ABOUT HOW DOMESTIC POLITICS SHAPE THE WAY PEOPLE SEE THE REST OF THE WORLD, TESTING THE IDEA THAT CONSERVATIVES TEND TO HOLD MORE NEGATIVE VIEWS OF FOREIGN COUNTRIES THAN LIBERALS.

The Architecture of Identity in Puebla, Mexico Nikki Membiela, Stetson University

BASED ON MY RESEARCH CONDUCTED IN PUEBLA, MEXICO, I LOOK AT RACIAL IDENTITY AND MIXTURE IN PUEBLA AND THE SURROUNDING TOWNS. EXPERIENCING PUEBLA BY STAYING WITH A LOCAL FAMILY AND TALKING TO PEOPLE FROM THE AREA ALLOWED FOR UNDERSTANDING FIRST-HAND WHAT IDENTITY MEANS IN DIFFERENT CONTEXTS. THE CITY OF PUEBLA SPECIFICALLY PROVIDES A UNIQUE, SPANISH-CENTERED VIEW OF IDENTITY THAT IS NOT COMMONLY REPRESENTED IN RESEARCH AND LITERATURE. THIS PRESENTATION DISCUSSES HOW STUDYING ABROAD CHANGED THE COURSE OF MY RESEARCH AND IS ALLOWING ME TO CONTRIBUTE TO AN UNDER-REPRESENTED FIELD IN A MEANINGFUL WAY.

I WILL SHARE HOW STUDYING ABROAD IN MÉXICO PROFOUNDLY SHAPED MY LIFE. MÉXICO WITNESSED MY JOURNEY OF OVERCOMING PERFECTIONISM AND EMBRACING LEARNING THROUGH LIVED EXPERIENCES. NAVIGATING A CULTURE I HAD ONCE STUDIED IN TEXTBOOKS, I LEARNED TO ACCEPT, EMBRACE, AND LAUGH AT MY MISTAKES. MÉXICO REDEFINED MY SENSE OF COMMUNITY AND TAUGHT ME TO APPRECIATE LIFE THROUGH SHARED DANCES, FOOD, MUSIC, AND MEMORIES WITH THOSE AROUND ME. RETURNING HOME I FACED REVERSE CULTURE SHOCK- I HAD OUTGROWN THE WORLD I LEFT BEHIND. EMPOWERED BY MY TIME AND COMMUNITY IN MÉXICO, I NOW STRIVE TO FOSTER A LIFE THAT REFLECTS THE LESSONS AND LIFESTYLE I DISCOVERED ABROAD.

Kikochō: Capturing Japan, One Page at a Time Abriami Srenivasan, Embry Riddle Aeronautical University HON 3042

MY PROFESSOR MADE A HANDMADE KIKOCHŌ, BELIEVING THAT COLLECTING SMALL MEMENTOS WAS THE BEST WAY TO CAPTURE OUR EXPERIENCES IN JAPAN. THIS SCRAPBOOK INCLUDES CLASS PROMPTS THAT HELPED ME REFLECT ON WHAT I SAW AND LEARNED.
