## **Update From the Vice President**



I am delighted to present the January USF World newsletter and to wish you a happy and healthy 2024!

This issue of Bulls Run the World focuses entirely on USF's engagement with India, including an overview of USF initiatives with Indian academic institutions, alumni living in India, Indian students at USF, and USF faculty with personal and professional ties to India. The building housing USF World is named in their honor. As the largest democracy in the world, India is an important strategic partner for the United States and a valued USF constituent.

During the early days of USF's relations with India, I was fortunate to participate in a Fulbright International Education Administrator program in 2013. Our delegation of 12 senior university leaders spent time learning about higher education policy and organization in India, participating in cultural events, and visiting a variety of universities, including public and private institutions in Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, and the state of Kerala. In 2014, I returned with a group of USF students to Pune, east of Mumbai, for the International Student Parliament. Last October, Provost Prasant Mohapatra and I had the good fortune to travel to India for a multicity itinerary that included visits with university partners, alumni, and the United States-India Educational Foundation, as well as the new consulate in Hyderabad. We hope you'll enjoy the highlights of our visit.

#### USF forges strong ties across India

India is a key market for international student recruitment – especially for high-demand STEM fields. Indian students constitute more than 25% of the over 1 million foreign students studying in the United States, according to the **2023 Open Doors Report** prepared by the State Department in collaboration with the Institute of International Education. The annual impact of international students to the U.S. economy is \$38 billion and 335,000 jobs created, with Indian students accounting for \$7.1 billion in 2022, according to the report.
